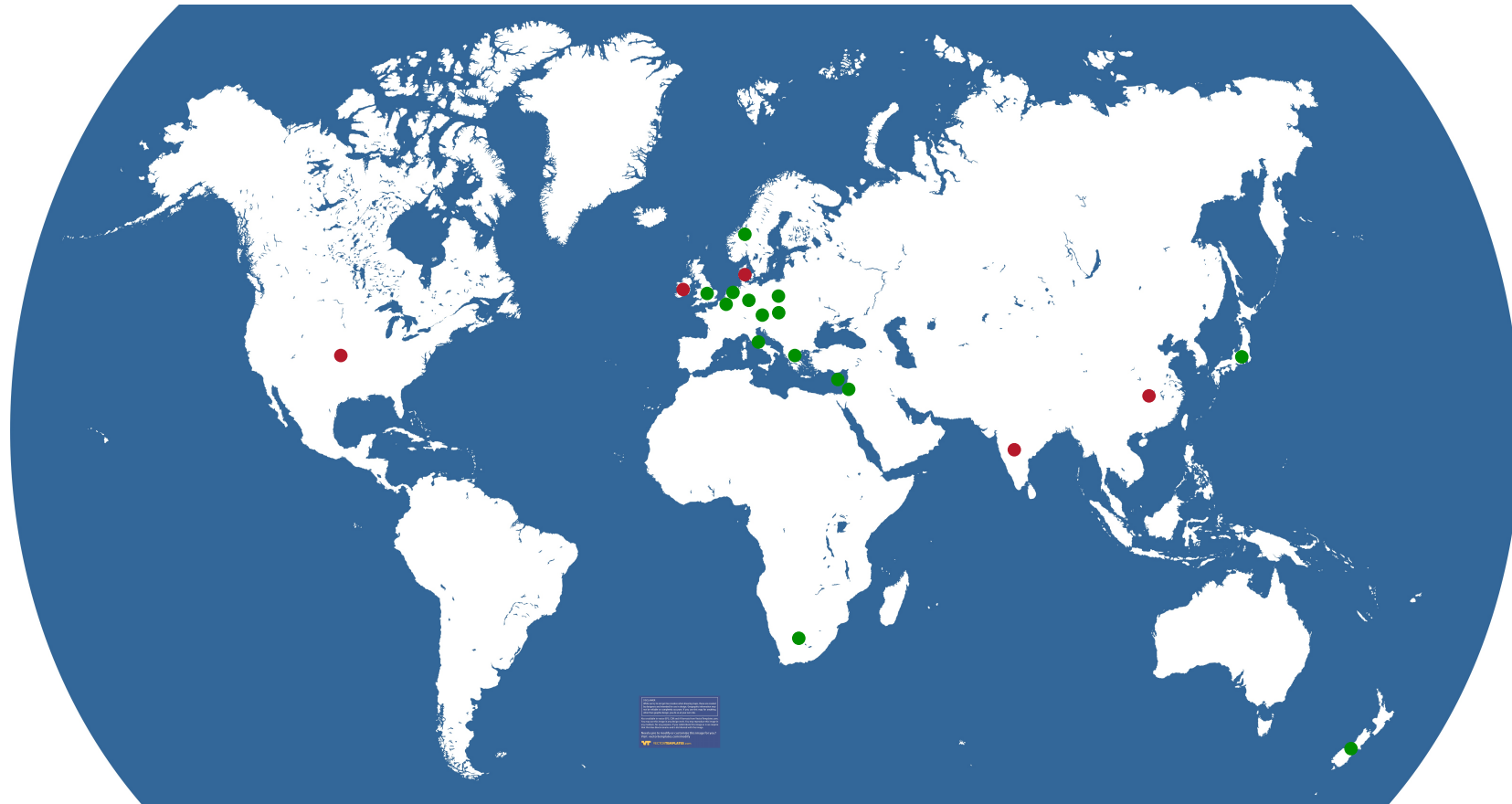
## An International Conference

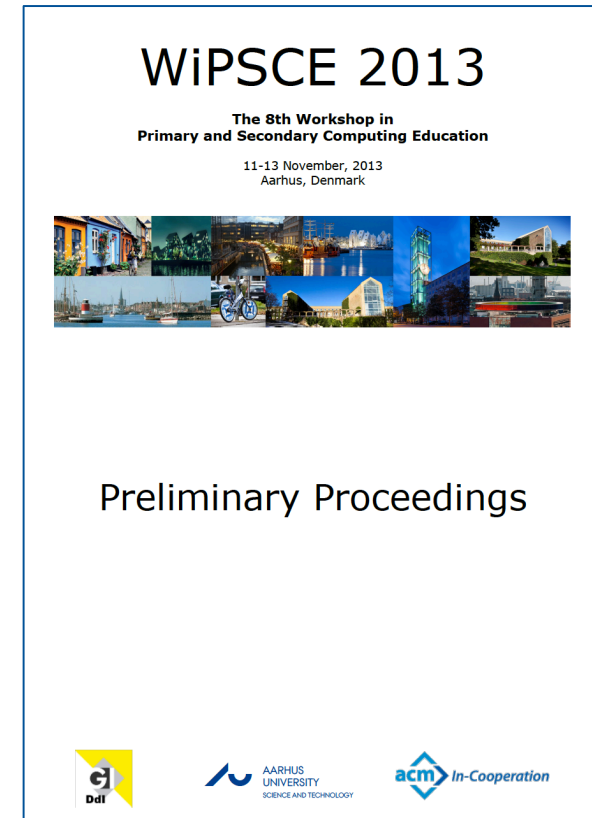

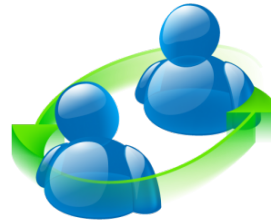

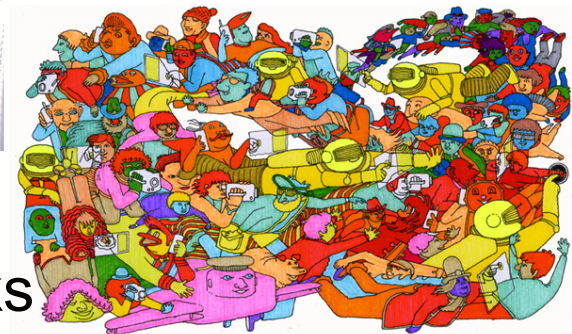
